## Dear parents,

We are very much looking forward to welcoming your children back to school in the coming days, more specifically being able to focus upon our core purpose of teaching and learning, and hopefully loosing less time to the disruption caused by the COVID 19 pandemic.

As you will be aware from wider society, many of the restrictions implemented whilst we as a nation attempted to bring the virus under control are now being lifted. One of the key weapons that we as a school have in protecting against the spread of the virus is the regime of regular testing.

As you are aware from earlier correspondence we are staggering the return to school in order to enable all year groups to complete two COVID tests on site. The table below hopefully makes it clear when each year group should attend for their test, and on which day each year group returns to school fully.

Can I thank all of you who have already completed the consent form, however this only amounts to 42% of our school population. In order to minimise the possible disruption caused by the virus it would be our objective for as many students as possible to have completed tests before returning to school. Currently our new Year 7's are leading the way with 78% involvement in the testing, but this reduces in our older age groups with only 30% of Year 11 having returned their consent form, and 25% of the 6<sup>th</sup> Form. Arguably these examination year groups will be those most impacted should they contract the virus.

Please could I ask all families to complete the following consent form for each of their children today.

<u>COVID Testing Consent Form</u> (Please use the year group that your child is returning to in September)

Of those who have already responded, 12% of you have confirmed that whilst you are not going to participate in the testing on site you will continue to conduct the twice weekly home testing. On completion of the school testing, all students will be provided with a further set of home test kits.

We have put in place the capacity to be able to test every student twice before their return to school, and each tutor group should attend at the times indicated below. Having completed the test students will return home immediately, the school as well as the NHS will contact any positive cases that are identified. The testing will take place in the main hall and all students should access the site via the main front entrance. Please attend in full school uniform – it will serve as a helpful check that you have everything ready for the first day proper!

Thank you for your cooperation with this, we look forward to seeing all those consent forms completed, and then eventually welcoming you back to the eagerly awaited academic year.
